

YHA BUSHWALKING
Navigation Training Day
Mt Disappointment State Forest
SATURDAY OCTOBER 6, 2018

Activity Details: Opportunity to develop your map and compass navigation skills off track in Mt Disappointment State Forest.
The distance for the day will be less than ten kilometres, but it is in fairly rugged country, and will be mostly off track, and may include one or more short, steep climbs. It will also include a lot of stopping to discuss and practice navigation skills.

Standard: Easy

Maps: Victoria Topographical Map 1:25,000 'Reedy Creek'
Copies will be supplied.

Directions for Drivers:

Take the Hume Highway north to the Clonbinane Exit.
Meet on the Clonbinane Exit Ramp at 10.15am.

Proceed from there in convoy.
Starting point for the day is the junction of Diggers Link 1 and Diggers Gully Road.

Clothes and Equipment: This is essentially an off track exercise, so a strong pair of comfortable boots and gaiters would be ideal. And I know its Spring, but bring a warm jacket ... and your waterproof jacket, just in case.

You'll need a compass, although please don't go out and buy one without speaking with me first. I do have a few spare compasses that can be used on the day.

Food: You will need lunch and munchies.

Water: Bring water for the day. Suggest at least one litre.
There may not be any water on route.

Transport: Car pooling to be arranged by leader.
